4. President General Business Report

- Meetings: During the 2023 year, the Executive Committee met monthly via Zoom.
- Executive:
 - o At the 2023 AGM both President Simon Weaving and Treasurer Stuart McBratney stepped down from their roles.
 - o Anne Chesher, was nominated and accepted the role of President.
 - o Susan Kerrigan was nominated and accepted the role of Vice President.
 - o Aaron Burton was nominated and accepted the role of Secretary.
 - o Tom Young was nominated and accepted the role of Treasurer.

All roles effective from August 2023.

• Research Sub-Committee:

Key points to report are:

- o 10 years since the research sub-committee was established,
- o Developed a Terms of Reference for the committee to be published on the website,
- Sightlines Issue 6 18 submissions received, 15 submissions went out for peer review, 34 peer review reports shared with submitters who will now respond to the feedback. Issue to be launched online in late August,
- o Planning for an HDR/ECR bootcamp at Swinburne University on the afternoon before the annual Conference.
- Learning and Teaching Sub-committee:

Key points to report are:

o The main focus of the Learning and Teaching Sub-committee has been to host two online symposiums. Following on from the successful 2023 conference panel on Diversity and Inclusion in the Screen production classroom the committee ran another session on the theme in December 2023. Associate Professor Nico Meisser hosted and we had four presenters - two from Western Australia and two based in Melbourne.

- o In February 2024 we hosted a symposium on the 'End of Year Exhibition' hosted by Dr Teresa Rizzo again with four presenters this time from Queensland, WA and Victoria. It was great to hear about the diverse ways in which we all work with students to both screen work for audiences and provide opportunities for fun and reflection.
- o Presenters from the symposiums have been invited to submit a one page for the website and encouraged to write up their findings in a formal piece for publishing.
- o The committee has also had a panel accepted at the upcoming conference in November on the use of Al in the Screen Production Classrooms.
- o We will be hosting another symposium shortly.

Conference:

o At the 2023 Conference, Susan Kerrigan offered to host the 2024 Annual Conference at Swinburne University in 27-29 November. A call for papers and the planning of the program has been conducted.

Industry Awareness:

- o In November an ASPERA Industry Awareness Initiative was instigated to bring together key people from Australia's peak screen bodies to collaborate on a significant research question that ASPERA could potentially undertake for the industry and to inform teaching and learning.
- o This venture has continued into 2024, with Screenrights, Screen Australia, Screen Producers Association, AIDC and Documentary Australia supporting and endorsing the initiative.
- o An Industry Forum collaborative workshop day is set for 29th August at Screenrights in Sydney.

 - o ASPERA has accumulated approximately \$50,000 which represents an opportunity for additional spending on an appropriate initiative to be discussed further


6. Election of new members
